Welcome to the California Consumer Privacy Act Notice for the ABILIFY MYCITE® System. The California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 ("CCPA") creates a variety of privacy rights for California consumers. We share the same information about our practices with everyone but use this notice to make disclosures required by the CCPA.

Personal Information We Collect

How We Use and Share Your Personal Information

In general, we use and share your Patient Personal Information as permitted or required by applicable laws, rules, or regulations, and for purposes relating to the operation of the ABILIFY MYCITE System, to improve the System, and to provide services to System users. Your Rights

CCPA provides California residents with the following privacy rights:

- Right to access personal information: You may request access to the categories and specific pieces of your personal information we hold
- **Right to data portability**: Upon request we will provide you with your personal information in a readily-useable format
- Right to deletion: You can ask us to delete your personal information we have collected
- **Right to disclosure**: You can receive additional information regarding the sources from which we collect information, the purposes for which

we collect and share personal information, the information of theirs we hold, and the categories of parties with whom we share their information

- Right to opt-out of sales: You have the right know if your personal information is being sold, shared for monetary or other valuable consideration (a "sale"). Otsuka does not sell your personal information, and thus we do not offer an opt out.
- Right to be free from discrimination: You may freely exercise these rights without fear of being denied goods or services. We may, however, provide a different level of service or charge a different rate reasonably relating to the value of your data
